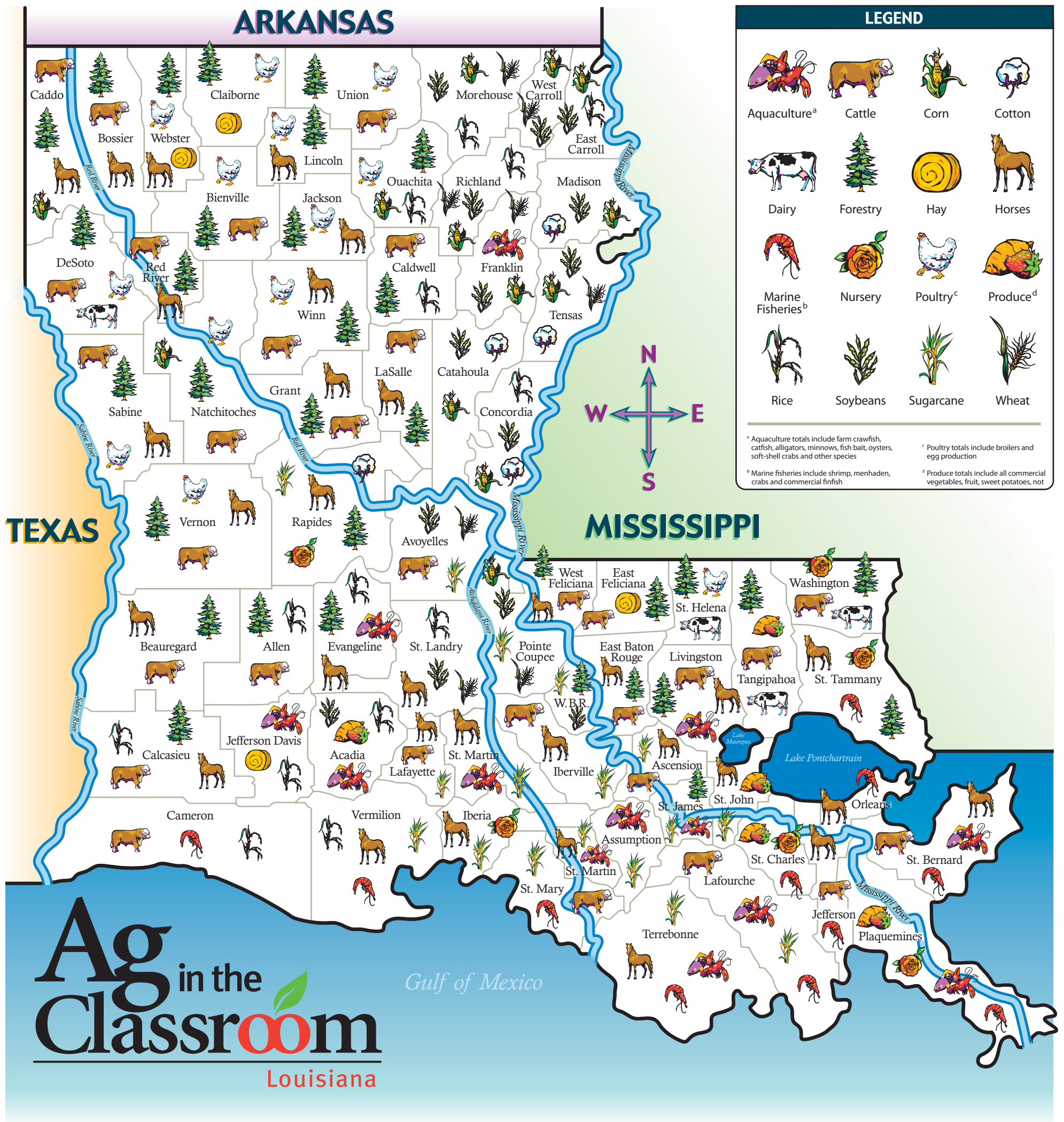


LOUISIANA'S AGRICULTURE
